





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What is the full EBacc?

- English (Language or Literature)
- Mathematics
- Science x 2 (your best 2 if you study separate science)
- History or Geography
- A foreign language

“Students first”

This group of subjects enables students to have greater choice at further and higher education

They demonstrate an ability to think with rigour

A study by the Sutton Trust showed that studying the Full EBacc can help students to do well in English and maths

Taking the EBacc enhances a student’s prospects of entering further education or employment

Government Ambition:

75% of students will be studying
the Full EBacc by 2022

This means that 3 out of 4 people that you are competing against for jobs and college places will potentially have achieved the Full EBacc

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Government Ambition:

90% of students will be studying
the Full EBacc by 2025

This means that by 2025, 9 out of 10 people
that you are competing against for jobs and
college places will potentially have achieved the
Full EBacc

- If you take a language and a humanities subject, you will be studying the Full EBacc
- All students will get the chance to study at least one non-EBacc subject if they want to
